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Description of Trust	Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Foundation Trust (CPFT) is a health and social care organisation, providing integrated community, mental health and learning disability services, across Cambridgeshire and Peterborough.
Overview of service	
	CPFT Nutrition and Dietetic Service is a welcoming and supportive place to work. We provide a service to a range of rural and urban areas across Cambridgeshire and are based at 4 sites namely: Cambourne (Cambridge), Doddington Hospital (Doddington), City Health Clinic (Peterborough) and Redshank House (Huntingdon). We see our patients in a variety of settings including clinics, home visits and inpatient settings as well as delivering group education in the community.
	We are made up of 4 specialist teams; Nutrition Support, Gastro, Diabetes and Mental Health. Along with the Dietitians we are fortunate to have a number of Dietetic Assistants and Dietetic Assistant Practitioners supporting our diverse service. We have a great admin support too.

teams	The gastro team holds Community gastroenterology clinics as well as running group Low FODMAP sessions
	Community Nutrition Support team :
	The team covers Home enteral feeding, oral nutrition support, older peoples' services (including intermediate care wards), home visits and outpatient clinics.
	Diabetes team :
	The Diabetes team run out-patient clinics for patients with

Type 1 and Type 2 diabetes and specialist MDT pump clinics. They also do some home visits as well as delivering regular structured education including PDAC and DESMOND.

### Mental Health team:

The team provides a service to both adult and adolescent mental health in-patients and runs community clinics (including eating disorders)

# Description of locations

### Huntingdon

Redshank House is one of our new bases. It is situated in the Hinchingbrooke Business park off the A1 and A14.

We currently share our office with the local Neighbourhood team which is made up of district nurses, physiotherapists and occupational therapists.

### **Doddington**

Doddington Community hospital is situated in the middle of the Fens, approximately 30miles from the centre of Cambridge.

There is a range of health care available at Doddington Community hospital including: Adult Speech & Language Therapy, Community Heart Failure Specialist Nursing & Respiratory Nursing, Fenland Anti-coagulation Service, Heart Failure specialist nursing, Musculo-skeletal Physiotherapy, Minor Treatment Centre, Outpatient and day rehabilitation Specialist neuro-rehabilitation service.

# Cambridge


Sackville House, Cambourne is one of our new bases. It is situated approx. 20 mins from Cambridge off the A428. We share a large open plan office with school nurses and local authority staff.

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## Peterborough

We use City Health Clinic as a Peterborough office base and share this with Tissue Viability, Speech and Language and Podiatry teams. A number of community clinics are run from this site.

### **Local Transport**

**Rail:** Cambridge and Huntingdon stations are connected with London Kings Cross station by a frequent service operated by First Capital Connect. Huntingdon is connected to Peterborough station by First Capital Connect, and then on to the North and Scotland by East Coast.

**Bus:** There are regular buses to Peterborough, St Neots, Ramsey, St Ives and Cambridge all direct from Huntingdon and Cambridge, as well as within the town and to <a href="Hinchingbrooke Hospital">Hinchingbrooke Hospital</a>. Most buses are provided by Stagecoach in Huntingdonshire or Go Whippet

Air: Stansted airport is within an hour's drive.
