Who are you?

As a pharmacist the patient is at the core of the service you deliver. Maintaining this as the golden thread from the organisation's vision; you will have the opportunity to not just deliver, but improve, steer and innovate how we deliver our services.

The ideal candidate will hold an equivalent Pharmacy degree, possess prior hospital experience, demonstrate excellent clinical and problem-solving skills, and have a strong commitment to patient safety.

You will be a self-motivated and driven individual, looking for role which has a blend of leadership and clinical work. The role comes with a supportive structure and a lead pharmacist to support you to meet the objectives outlined within the Job Description. Whilst the objectives are outlined, the route is yours to determine.

What does weekends and on call mean?

To provide the best care, we offer a 7 day service but don't worry, we know to be at your best you need downtime and time to recharge.

We aim to protect as much of your out of hours space as we can. Therefore, our EDC is structured so that everyone does a little, so no one needs to do a lot. Currently this means:

- Weekends ~ 1 in 12
- Late nights – one every other week
- On call ~ 1 per month
 - o Very low physical call out
 - o Electronic drug cabinets on all wards meaning you can check stock by remotely logging in
 - o The robot will also have an out of hours chute, meaning you can dispense stock from home
- Bank holidays – 2 per year (usually one worked and/or one on call)

More ways to help you reach your potential

In addition to all the fantastic opportunities you'll have as part of our large, major trauma centre, Trust and UHCWi methodology we will cover all the basics too:

The pharmacy department will be dedicated to ensuring that you are able to utilise your skills and maximise your growth and potential. We have a strong ethos of staff development and innovation which we strongly believe can help build the foundations of delivering high quality services.
